### **RESOLUTION NO. 2010-01**

## A RESOLUTION OF THE TRI-VALLEY TRANSPORTATION COUNCIL APPROVING AN INTERIM FUNDING PLAN FOR THE TRI-VALLEY TRANSPORTATION DEVELOPMENT FEE PROGRAM

WHEREAS, in 1995, the Tri-Valley Transportation Council (TVTC) adopted the "Tri-Valley Transportation Plan/Action Plan for Routes of Regional Significance (TVTP/AP);" and

WHEREAS, the TVTP/AP identified eleven specific transportation improvements to be given high priority for funding; and

WHEREAS, in 1998, the TVTC adopted a Joint Exercise of Powers Agreement Pertaining to Tri-Valley Transportation Development (TVTD) Fees for Traffic Mitigation ("JEPA") to allow for the collection of impact fees to be used to fund the eleven high priority projects; and

WHEREAS, in 1999, the TVTC adopted a Strategic Expenditure Plan to establish a funding plan for collected TVTD Fees; and

WHEREAS, in 2004, the TVTC adopted an update to the Strategic Expenditure Plan (SEP) that reflected an update to the regional and sub-regional transportation outlook for the Tri-Valley; and

WHEREAS, funding was programmed to seven projects in the 2004 SEP Update; and

WHEREAS, four of the seven projects are complete, leaving three projects for which funds have been programmed but not yet disbursed; and

WHEREAS, an interim funding plan has been developed that matches the programmed amounts and priorities as established in the 2004 SEP Update with a revised disbursement timeline to reflect the current Joint TVTD Fee Account balance and projected fee collections over the next five years and to reaffirm commitment to the high priority projects.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Parties agree to adopt the 2010 Interim Funding Plan (Exhibit A).
